


Dahl Class – Autumn Term 2

Is exploring important?

Please choose 2 tasks below from separate areas (you are welcome to complete more if you wish) to complete, these should be brought into school between, Monday 8th December and Wednesday 10th December when we will celebrate the children's hard work. This homework will also be used as a display of all your hard work.

Maths	Create your own addition snakes and ladders board game and challenge a family member to a game.	Draw a table and record the time the sun rises in the morning and sets in the evening to investigate how day length varies.	Make a Christmas model from recycled materials such as cereal boxes, cardboard tubes etc. Write a list of the 3D shapes you have used to make your model.
English	Read a book and write a character description for your favourite character. You could draw a picture of your character if you wish.	Write a non-chronological report about Christmas trees using these headings: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Decorating at Christmas - Different types of trees - Where do you find Christmas trees? 	Create a firework shape poem. Here are some examples. 
Big Question	Think about the famous landmarks that you know in the UK. Choose your favourite and then research and write down 5 facts about it.	Choose an ornament or sculpture from in your house and draw it. Challenge - try to make it look as 3D as possible.	Create a poster to answer the Big Question – Is Exploring Important? Think about your learning since September to help you.
