English	Write a description of your type of transport (e.g. bike, car, train, aeroplane). Think about * What does it look like? * What does it feel like? * What does it feel like to be on it?	Write a diary for a journey to school. Remember to think about how you felt on this journey.	Write a recount of a time when you have been on holiday. Remember to think about how you felt whilst on holiday.
