

## Class 3 –Summer Term 1

### Do humans damage the Earth? How and Why?

<b>Art and design</b>	Design and make a rainforest model. What could you use from our natural or man-made environment? Think about the different layers in the rainforest.	Look at some of the artwork inspired by rainforests and glaciers of Alaska. Create your own design using materials of your choice. (collage, paint, pencil, watercolour, chinks, colour pencils)	Design an invention to help mitigate the effects of global warming.
<b>Maths / English</b>	Research what is happening to the rainforest and the glaciers of Alaska. How are the habitats of many animals being destroyed? Write a formal letter to the Government to persuade them to 'Save our Rainforests and Glaciers'.	Using your knowledge of data handling, create charts and graphs to show data that interests you. This could be favourite rainforest animals, rainfall for each month in the rainforest or something else of your choice!	Create a story about the life of a child who survives in the rainforest. How did they get there? Are there other tribes there? What will they see? What adventures does the character go on? Does it end happily?
<b>Big Questions (demonstrate your answers to these however you see fit)</b>	How can we live in more sustainable way?	Which people or organisations around the world are campaigning for change?	What has had more of a devastating impact on the world- deforestation or the ice melting? Why?
