I hope you all had a fantastic Easter. We have another exciting term ahead of us and are looking forward to sharing our great work with you all.

We will be continuing to explore our big question: Why do humans create art? Our focus for this term will be on investigating the work of key artists - Lowry, Picasso, Rodin and Heckel. We will then be creating our pieces of arts using different mediums to imitate their style and techniques.

In English, the children will be writing their own persuasive brochure for taking a holiday in Spain. The children will be learning about persuasive techniques to use in their writing and researching about Spain. They will be learning information about Spain from links to a Spanish primary school. The children will be able to ask the Spanish children questions to gain ideas about life in Spain through live Zoom sessions and postcards.

In Maths, the children are starting their new topic on money. The children will be learning how to convert between pounds and pence and practising giving and receiving change. Children will work towards solving simple problems with money, involving all four operations.

In Science we will be starting our Electricity topic. The children will be constructing a simple series electrical circuit, identifying and naming its basic parts, including cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers.
