Art and design	Stone Age people build shelters to live in using materials they had gathered. Gather some natural materials and build a model shelter.	Design and make an ancient stone circle or a replica of Stonehenge. Be creative in the way you make your stone circle.	Create a timeline to show just how long ago The Stone Age and The Bronze Age were. What other ages can you add to your timeline?
Maths / English	Compare the lengths and heights of different prehistoric animals	Make maps of surviving UK monuments from the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages.	Make a visitor's guide to Stonehenge or Flag Fen.
Big Questions (demonstrate your answers to these however you see fit)	Where the best places to build Stone Age and Bronze Age settlements are and why?	What are the tools that were created during the Stone Age that we still use today?	What period of history is more influential: The Stone Age or The Bronze Age? Explain why.
