

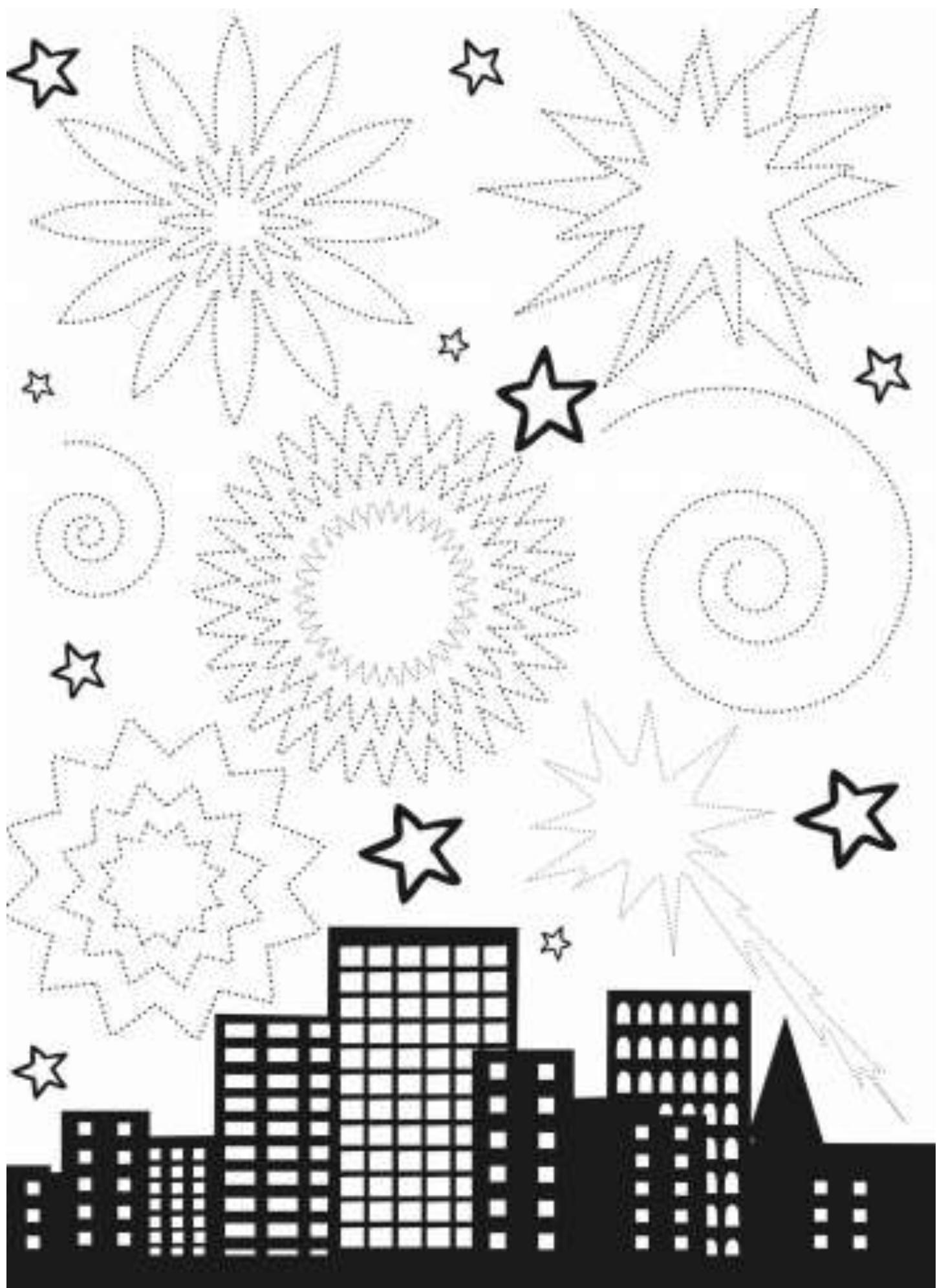
Dahl Class – Autumn Term 2

Focus is on Motor Skills and Handwriting.

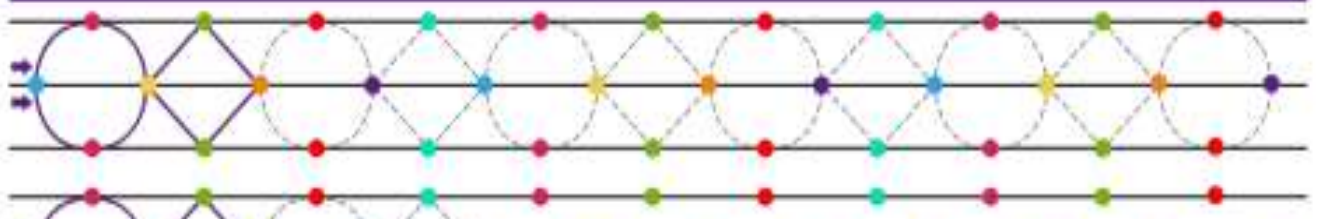
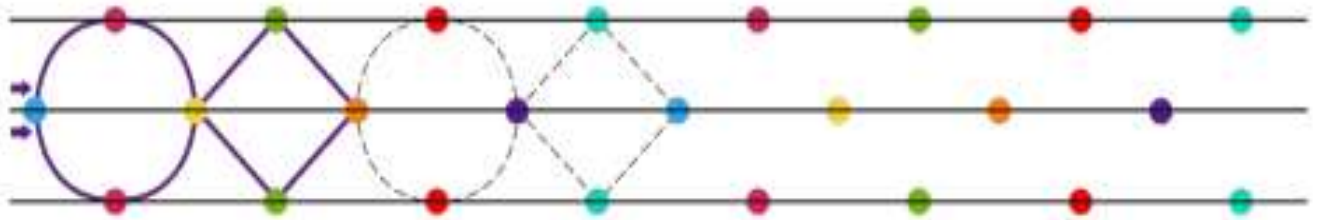
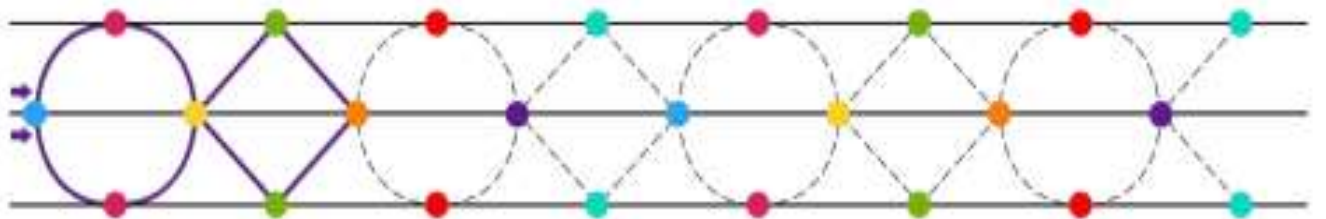
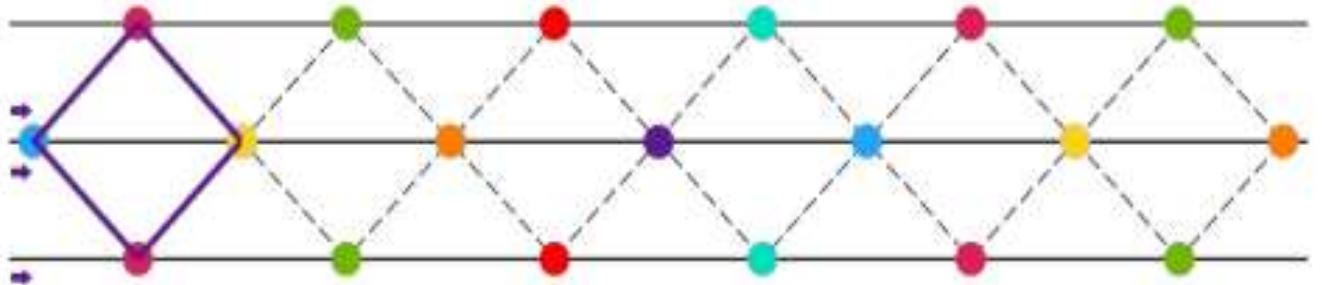
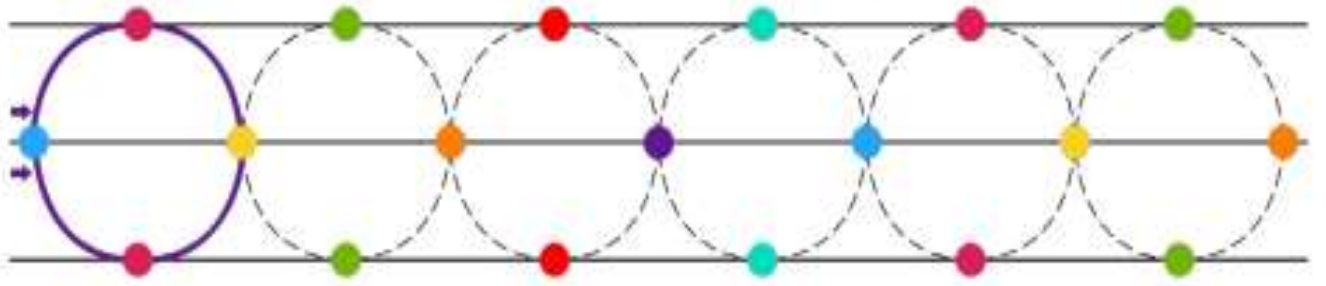
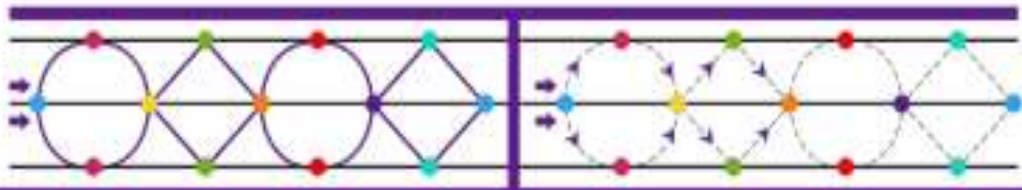
