We will be continuing with our work on our Big Question: Why have buildings changed over time? Our focus for this term will be on the subjects: Geography and Art. Within these subjects we will be exploring the four countries that make up the UK and looking at the different types of buildings that can be found in the UK. Our Art learning will be based on the work of Paul Klee and will be linked in with our understanding of shapes. We will be continuing our Science work on materials. We will be applying our learning from last term to help us investigate which material would be the best to make a parachute for Humpty Dumpty.

In English, the children will participate in regular Read Write Inc phonics sessions and regular reading skills sessions in which we will be retelling the stories we have read and looking at how the different characters are feeling. During our writing skills sessions, we will be developing our understanding of the four different types of sentences (statements, questions, commands and exclamations) before writing a set of instructions on how to clean a window.

In Maths we will be working on our understanding of addition and subtraction using a variety of different methods, including using our recall of number bonds, using a number-line and using the dienes to help us. We will then be naming and exploring the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

In RE we will be discussing and exploring the question: Who do Christians believe made the world?

Homework and Spellings

The most valuable homework you can do with your child is to set aside a short and daily piece of time where you share, read and enjoy books together.

We will also be carrying on with setting Mathematics and Reading Eggs tasks on alternate weeks.

Spellings will continue to be sent home on a Monday and will be checked the following Monday.

PE lessons will be on a Tuesday, please can you ensure your child comes into school in their PE clothing.
