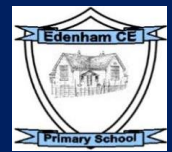

Please consider our community at drop off and pick up times and ensure we are parking responsibly to ensure all remain safe. We are very lucky to have the Village Hall to be able to park at.

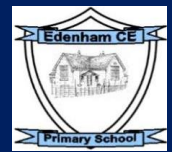
Perspective Parents
