We are looking forward to welcoming you to our Open Morning on Wednesday 20th and Thursday 21st November. You will be shortly receiving a letter confirming times and day for this.

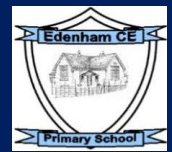
## Christmas Cards
