



## Edenham Church of England Primary School Blended Learning Plan

Device and access survey completed: At this point, all families feel they have the necessary devices to cope with home learning	
Scenario	School provision
1: Child is absent from school due to being unwell/ symptomatic	No work to be set.
2: Child is instructed to self isolate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Day 1 of absence to be covered via generic Day 1 learning pack provided by class teacher.</li> </ul> From Day 2 onwards: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School to send links to Oak Academy live video support from teachers' weekly planning.</li> <li>• Class teacher to provide at least 'two check ins' each week linked to learning in class.</li> <li>• Pupil to email completed learning into school via the office for teacher feedback</li> <li>• Pupils in Reception will have work provided via Tapestry and completed work, photos etc should be posted up here.</li> <li>• Teacher to provide regular feedback/ acknowledgement.</li> </ul>
3: Class bubble is disbanded and whole class are self isolating OR school is instructed to close	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• School to provide daily inputs to class of up to 20 mins for Maths and English (either: phonics/ writing/ GPS) every Mon/Tues/ Thurs/ Fri via Teams channels. These will be pre-recorded by the class teacher to allow ease of access for families with more than one sibling. This can be further supported by links and resources from Oak Academy.</li> <li>• During the course of a week, pupils will also access the following as a <b>minimum</b> provision: two reading sessions, one Connections session, one RE session, one MFL (for KS2), one music session and one science session. This will either be in the form of tasks to complete, live video input from Oak Academy or other resources, or may include input from the class teacher.</li> <li>• In the event of school closure, every Wednesday will become "Wellbeing Wednesday" which will focus on the mental health and wellbeing of all pupils. On this day, activities will relate more to physical fitness, health, well-being linking to current learning from PSHE. Also on this day, class teachers will have a timetabled class call using Zoom/ Teams which all pupils will be invited to.</li> <li>• Suggested timings of each sessions can be found class pages via the school website</li> <li>• Athletics, Reading Eggs and KIRF for maths are all available to children at all times</li> </ul>
4: Staff member instructed to self isolate (not unwell)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Class teacher to provide daily planning for class cover lead, as per usual timetable.</li> </ul>

5. Staff member absent due to ill health

- Class teachers upload planning to school G drive on weekly basis.
- Senior leaders to provide any additional lesson resourcing to support class cover lead.
